Measles Immunization Requirement

The State of Oregon requires that: “Any full-time student born on or after January 1, 1957 needs to show that they’ve been vaccinated against measles when enrolling in a college or university as a full-time student (undergraduate and graduate).”

All applicants for full-time study at Mount Angel Seminary born after 1956, must meet the Oregon vaccination requirement by **one of the following methods**:

1. Vaccination. Provide evidence of 2 doses of measles vaccination. This can be a copy of your vaccination history or a note from your doctor’s office.
 - a. The vaccine may be noted as Measles or MMR, in Spanish: Sarampión or SPR
 - b. Many states have immunization records online that can be requested:
 - i. <https://www.cdc.gov/iis/contacts-locate-records/index.html>
 - c. 2 separate doses are required, they should each be dated
2. Blood test for immunity. Your doctor can order a blood test to check for immunity to measles. Please provide a copy of the blood test results showing immunity.
3. Medical Exemption. Please provide a note from your doctor’s office indicating a medical exemption for measles vaccination.
4. Non-Medical Exemption. You can get a non-medical exemption, by following the instructions on the website below and printing an education certificate
